


Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths from COVID-19 in the U.S.

March 1, 2020 - May 4, 2021




U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type



Weekly Count of U.S. Deaths and Excess Deaths



As of April 23, 2021


