
BOND MARKET RETURNS

(1/1/26 – 2/28/21, Total return for first two months of calendar year)







Growth of \$100k for large-cap, mid-cap and small-cap stocks



Mid-cap stocks have trailed large-caps over the last 5 years

Large-cap has outperformed over last 5 years



3-year rolling, U.S. large-cap stock returns minus U.S. min vol stock returns 6/2/08 - 2/28/21





Average annual return for each hypothetical scenario


